- What:** TD Bank Bike Philly celebrates the freedom of car-free streets and is open to riders of all ages and skill levels. The event features 10 and 20 mile car-free loops and a chance to extend the ride to 35 or 50 miles on shared roads. www.bikephilly.org
- Where:** The ride begins at the Art Museum, takes bicyclists through the heart of Center City and hidden corners of Fairmount Park. Bicyclists have an option to extend their ride to 35 and 50 miles and ride through the local main line suburbs.
